San Sebastian



The city has settled around the unique bay of La Concha (the Shell), and on the banks of the mouth of the river Urumea. Within the same district, mountains and beaches shape an exceptional display of urban scenery combining carefully tended architectural features with a unique natural landscape.

How the Basques worship this art is best reflected in San Sebastian which has been awarded more Michelin guide stars than any place in the world and offers a wide variety of restaurants and bars serving up top chefs' star dishes alongside miniature haute cuisine in the form of pintxos (appetizer).

- ¥ San Sebastian is a coastal city.
- ¥ Situated in the Basque Country, less than 100 kilometres from Bilbao and 40 from the French city of Biarritz.
- ¥ With just over 180,000 inhabitants, it is connected both nationally and internationally by a vast network of motorways.
- ¥ It has a high speed rail link and five airports within a one hundred kilometre radius.
- ¥ San Sebastian has 3,600 hotel beds within the city centre.


Reasons to discover the Basque Country?








Services

Urumea terrace Level 0 3,000 m²





Zurriola terrace Level 1






Auditorium Foyer Level 0
